Project introductie:

To engage DAE students with trees and encourage them to interact with their natural surroundings, Atelier NL took them to the forest. They were asked to sit with a tree for an entire day, walk through the forest with a forest manager, and cut down a large maple tree. Suddenly, emotions were involved — when the tree finally fell, there was a realisation that this was a living being. Each student took a part of the tree — from the roots to the sap and leaves — and used it for their own projects.

Project introductie:

Trees are good for climate stabilization, soil regeneration, recreation, and general happiness. They can also provide nutritious food such as nuts, which can be made into hazelnut milk, or a cheese made from walnuts. These all have the potential to become Dutch staple foods of the future. Timm Donke presents HOUTLAND, an ambitious plan to reforest the Netherlands by 2060 in order to create a eco-friendly, tree-based society. The project reveals possible scenarios of a radical green future.

Naam: Forest Wool — Tamara Orjola

Project introductie:

Pine trees are the world's main source of timber. Every year, 600 million pine trees are cut down in the EU alone. But there is more to the tree than just wood: pine needles account for 20 to 30 percent of its mass. Designer Tamara Orjola wondered why the needles would go unused, and found them to be a great alternative for all kinds of fibers. An elegant series of stools and carpets made of nothing but pine needles shows that this ecological material also has a high-quality look and feel to it.

Naam: Poplars — Lex Pott | Weltevree

Project introductie:

Poplars are unmistakably inspired by the cultural legacy of the Dutch wooden shoe. Lex used the original material of poplar wood as a starting point, but tradition was central to the redesign as well. "After all these years, it's still a convenient and natural shoe for gardening. By giving it a new silhouette and a more refined look, I wanted to gear up the wooden shoe for the future. Redefining such an icon for modern life is a dream come true."
